Cambria Center for the Arts (CCA) welcomes member artists to apply for a Member Artist Gallery Stations. Once accepted by a jury, the artist will be given a folding wooden art bin or four art pedestals with the wall space directly above it. The Gallery will be providing eight of these Member Artist Section, which will be located in the South hallway opposite the Theatre hallway.

Requirements

- Artists must be a current member
- All work must be original art of the member artist's own creation. No reproductions.
- All of the work included must be for sale.
- Artists are responsible for hanging their own artwork and filling their bin or placing art on the pedestals. CCA will provide oversight and assistance.
- Artist may come in the gallery during gallery business hours to replace or change work in their section.
- Artists who have work in the cabinets can apply for the Member Artist Sections, but the work must be unique to each area (i.e. jewelry in the cabinets and 2D original painting in the Member Artist Section)
- Artists who participate in the Member Artist Section may reapply once the 4 month time period is over.
- Two artists can share one Member Artist Gallery Section. For example, a sculpture artist can occupy the four pedestals and a 2D artist can hang paintings above on the wall.
- CCA retains 30% commission on all sales. Commission checks are sent out before the end of the following month. You will be required to submit a W-9 form in advance (provided in the Featured Artist Packet).
